Saturday 4 March 2023

Monday 6 March 2023

Today is Norfolk's Foundation Day public holiday. On 6 March 1788 Lieutenant Philip Gidley King arrived with the first settlers - a party of fifteen convicts, 9 males, 6 females and 7 free men, to take control of Norfolk Island so the Island didn't fall into the hands of the French who were also interested in the South Pacific. Foundation Day celebrates this historical occasion and attracts many visitors especially those who are researching their family heritage. The re-enactment and celebrations all take place at Kingston, the World Heritage area of Norfolk Island. This will be followed by lunch under the marquee at Kingston.

Tuesday 7 March 2023

This morning head to Fletcher's Mutiny Cyclorama & Art Gallery. The Cyclorama provides a total experience. Visitors walk inside one continuous 360° panoramic painting and feel as though they are standing on a pier or ship deck and are a part of the scenes. Visit another host who is making local salt from the oceans that surround our little island. You will taste of our local beef and the salt they are producing for cooking and table. Then moving on to meet another Norfolk Islander where you'll view a cooking demonstration. You will see and hear about our traditional dishes that were handed down by our Tahitian foremothers. This evening you will be partaking in a 3-course Progressive Dinner where you will enjoy the warm hospitality of different Norfolk Island family homes and learn about their heritage and life on Norfolk Island.

luxurious hideaway and maintained their privacy to ensure that Colleen had the perfect environment for her writing. Some of her most powerful titles were created in this much-loved sanctuary. Ric and Colleen's home was never open to the public until her passing. This exclusive guided tour to the author's magnificent property takes you through Ric and Colleen's home and you will be able to view some of their priceless collections from around the world. This afternoon, you will be picked up from your hotel and transferred to Pitcairn Settlers Village where you will learn about the colourful history of Norfolk's most recent settlement – the Pitcairn descendants. Experience the history and culture of the Pitcairn Settlers. View the magnificent homestead gardens, including many traditional crops.

Thursday 9 March 2023

Learn about the milking and cheese making process, then sit down to a delicious Hilli Goat style feast of beautiful local produce, handmade cheeses and breads, fresh fish and so much more. A complimentary glass of wine is also included. This afternoon will be at your own leisure. Tonight, you will have an eagle-eyed view of the tiny crescent-shaped beach and the magnificent spread of ocean stretching to the far horizon. The beautifully set tables will delight you – it's the most glamorous picnic you will ever attend! Scrumptiously fresh, local fish is prepared the local way and accompanied with a range of seasonal island dishes including those passed down from our Polynesian fore-mothers. This extends even to dessert. Our feast kicks off with entertainment, by a local singer and Tahitian-style dancers.

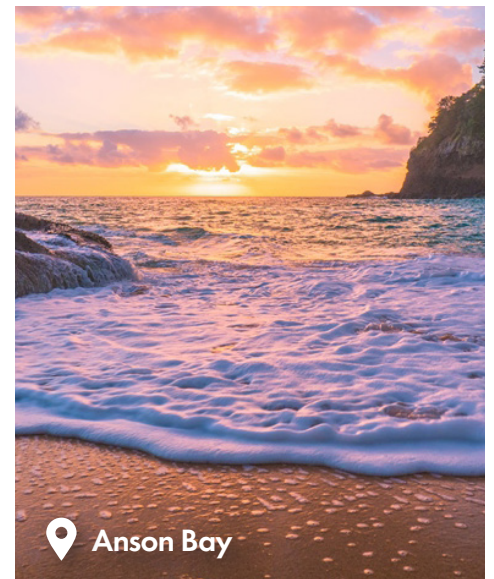
Saturday 11 March 2023
