

The Layout follows a classic Victorian-era design together with a diverse and layered landscape. The Melbourne botanica Gardens attract 1,900,00 vistors annually for a reason. It is a treasured part of cultural life and a vauluable assest to the heritage rich city.

With its stunning vistas, tranquil lakes and diverse plant collections, the Gardens are a place of continual discovery and delight.

At the Dandenong Gardens witness an explosion of colour as flowers burst into bloom throughout the magnificent gardens of the Yarra Valley and Dandenong Ranges.
