Day 1: Monday 4 January 2027

Brisbane to Buenos Aires, Argentina

Depart Brisbane on your international flight to Buenos Aires. Upon arrival, you will be met by your private English-speaking guide and transferred to your hotel. Porter service will be included on arrival. The remainder of the day is at leisure to relax and settle in after your journey.

4 Nights: *Dazzler Polo*

Day 2: Tuesday 5 January

Buenos Aires - Culture, Local Flavours & Tango

This morning, enjoy a half-day guided city tour exploring Buenos Aires' most iconic and historic areas. Begin in La Boca, one of Buenos Aires' most vibrant neighbourhoods, famous for its colourful houses and artistic atmosphere. This area is also deeply connected to Argentina's football culture, being home to Boca Juniors and its iconic stadium, La Bombonera, where Diego Maradona became a symbol of passion and identity for the club and its supporters. Continue to San Telmo, the oldest neighbourhood in Buenos Aires, known for its colonial architecture and cobblestone streets. Enjoy a traditional lunch in San Telmo, immersing yourself in the local flavours of Argentine cuisine. After lunch, continue to Puerto Madero, one of South America's most exclusive waterfront districts, where the city transforms into a modern landscape of skyscrapers, fine dining and renovated docks. Enjoy a walk along the waterfront, including views of the iconic Puente

de la Mujer. Return to your hotel in the afternoon and enjoy some time at leisure. In the evening, experience a traditional Tango Dinner Show at La Ventana, including transfers and a captivating performance showcasing Argentina's music, dance and culture.

Day 3: Wednesday 6 January

Buenos Aires - Argentine Asado Experience

Enjoy a relaxed morning at leisure. Later, immerse yourself in a traditional Fogón Asado experience, where you will discover authentic Argentine cooking techniques, open-fire grilling and local wines in a social and intimate setting.

Day 4: Thursday 7 January

Buenos Aires - Gamboa Wine Experience

After breakfast, depart Buenos Aires for a premium wine experience at Gamboa Winery, located in the countryside just outside the city. Enjoy a guided introduction to Argentine wine culture, including tastings of iconic varietals such as Malbec, while learning about the winemaking process in a relaxed and scenic setting. Following the tasting, indulge in a three-course lunch paired with local wines, offering a refined and immersive gastronomic experience. Return to Buenos Aires in the afternoon. The remainder of the day is at leisure.

Day 5: Friday 8 January

Buenos Aires to Santiago, Chile

After breakfast, you will be privately transferred from your hotel to Buenos Aires domestic airport (AEP) for your flight to Santiago. Porter service will be included. Upon arrival, meet your guide and transfer to your hotel. Begin your introduction to Santiago with a visit to the Central Market, where you will enjoy a local lunch experience. Continue to Cerro San Cristóbal for panoramic views over the city and the Andes Mountains. Return to your hotel. The Costanera Center is located nearby for those wishing to explore.

2 Nights: Pullman Santiago Vitacura

Day 6: Saturday 9 January

Santiago & Valparaíso

Travel to Valparaíso, a UNESCO World Heritage-listed coastal city. Explore colourful hills, artistic streets and visit La Sebastiana, Pablo Neruda's former home. Continue to Casablanca Valley for a winery experience including wine tasting and gourmet lunch. Return to Santiago.

Day 7: Sunday 10 January

Santiago to San Antonio, Chile / Embark Cruise

Transfer from Santiago to the coastal port of San Antonio and embark your Holland America cruise. This region is framed by the Andes and the Coastal Range, with historic towns, colourful seaside villages, and renowned wine valleys stretching between the city and the sea. Settle on board and enjoy your first evening at sea.

A full day at sea allows you to relax, enjoy onboard amenities, lectures from naturalists, and panoramic ocean views as you sail south along Chile's dramatic Pacific coastline.

Day 9: Tuesday 12 January

Puerto Montt / Puerto Varas, Chile

Arrive in Puerto Montt, the gateway to Chile's Lake District. Explore the German-influenced architecture, bustling markets, and scenic waterfront. Excursions may take you to nearby Puerto Varas, with views across Lake Llanquihue and snow-capped volcanoes. Sample regional cuisine, stroll along lakeside promenades, and enjoy the blend of natural beauty and local culture.

Day 10: Wednesday 13 January

Puerto Chacabuco, Chile

Visit the remote Patagonian port of Puerto Chacabuco. While the town itself is modest, excursions take you to the Río Simpson National Reserve reveal waterfalls, crystal-clear rivers, and lush forests. Take the opportunity to hike, fish, or simply enjoy the pristine scenery of southern Chile.

Day 11: Thursday 14 January
Chilean Fjords / At Sea

Cruise through Chile's fjords, where glaciers flow from towering mountains into deep blue waters. Observe rugged coastlines, remote islands, and abundant wildlife including sea lions, dolphins, and seabirds, as you sail through the Reloncaví Estuary and surrounding fjords.

Day 12: Friday 15 January
Sarmiento Channel / Glaciers

Continue past the Southern Patagonian Ice Field, cruising channels such as the Sarmiento. From the ship deck, admire glaciers like Amalia and El Brujo, the striking hues of ice and water, and local wildlife thriving in this untouched wilderness.

Day 13: Saturday 16 January
**Strait of Magellan / Punta Arenas /
Cockburn & Beagle Channels, Chile**

Sail through the historic Strait of Magellan, reaching the southern city of Punta Arenas. This vibrant port is known for its colonial architecture, bustling plazas, and as a gateway to Patagonian adventures including penguin colonies and nearby nature reserves. Continue cruising through the Cockburn and Beagle Channels, a region rich in exploration history and framed by dramatic glaciers, rugged mountains, and pristine waterways.

Day 14: Sunday 17 January
Glacier Alley / Ushuaia, Argentina

Cruise through Glacier Alley along the Beagle Channel. Arrive in Ushuaia, the world's southernmost city, surrounded by towering mountains and forests. Explore the port town's maritime museums, local

eateries, and take in the dramatic natural setting.

Cape Horn / Drake Passage

Round legendary Cape Horn and enter the Drake Passage, where the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans meet. Witness the raw power of these waters and the seabirds that inhabit the area.

A day at sea crossing the Drake Passage, with time to relax on board and enjoy lectures, activities, and the ship's amenities.

Antarctica Experience

After a day and a half crossing the Drake Passage, which separates South America from Antarctica, your Holland America ship will arrive at the White Continent. Explore Antarctica, sailing among icebergs, glaciers, and islands along the Antarctic Peninsula. Observe wildlife including penguins, seals, and seabirds, and visit locations such as Cuverville Island and Paradise Harbor. Learn about research stations and marvel at the extraordinary stillness and scale of this remote wilderness.

A day at sea as the ship begins its journey northward, reflecting on the remarkable landscapes and wildlife of Antarctica.

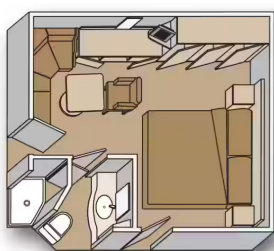

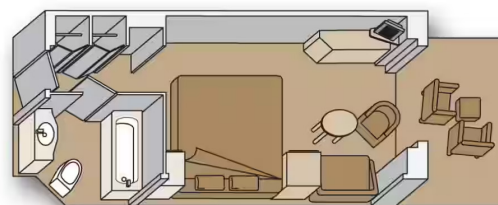
