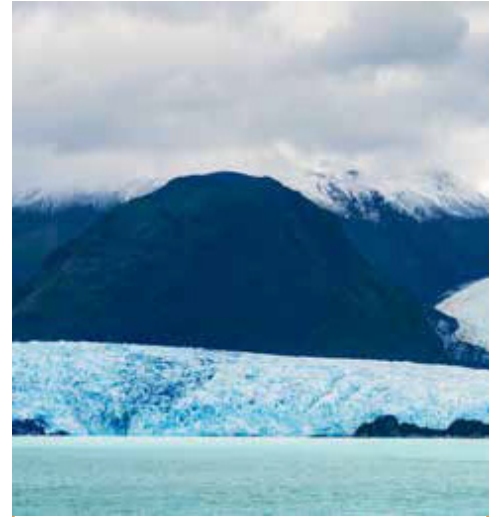
BUENOS AIRES

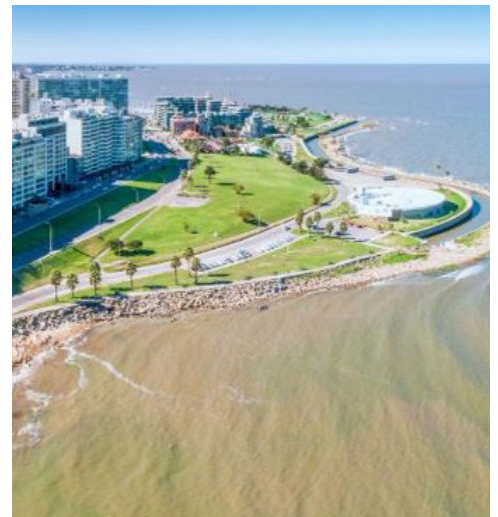
USHUAIA
